Due to expansion, we are looking to appoint an enthusiastic self-starter to lead one other staff member in meeting the needs of max. 16 children, as part of our Pre-School Nursery Team. The team will be based in our Forest School classrooms, which are located in our grounds, a short distance from the main school buildings.

Planning will be completed with the guidance and support of the unit Teacher. The role also requires tracking, monitoring and recording, and report writing, as well as being the Key Worker for a number of children. Attendance at a number of additional parent consultation evenings is also required.

The successful candidate must hold a full and relevant Level 3 Qualification, as defined by the Department for Education Early Years Qualification List. A Forest School qualification would be desirable.

Experience of working with pre-school children aged 2-4 years is essential. Willingness to train is key, along with being comfortable working under their own initiative, within both internal and external environments, is essential. Candidates must be prepared to work within and be supportive of the School's Church of England ethos and values.
